## *TERMS AND CONDITIONS*

- The Aleph Bet Jewish Day School or its designated representative will conduct the raffle drawing at the Aleph Bet Gala & Auction on March 11, 2018. The person who purchased the selected raffle ticket (the "Winner") will be notified by phone and/or email as provided on their ticket stub on March 15, 2018.
- The Winner is entitled to two round-trip economy class airline flights to and from any major international airport, dinner for two at the restaurant of his or her choice, and a two-night stay at a hotel for two (the "Prize").

## TERMS AND CONDITIONS - CONTINUED

- The destination and restaurant will be selected by the Winner. Aleph Bet will select the airline and hotel, equivalent in quality to a four-star hotel (or best available, if the location chosen has no superior hotels). Upgrades in air travel or accommodations may be made at the Winner's sole cost and expense. **The Prize does not include bush flights or ground transportation, alcoholic beverages, or any other entertainment or services beyond those explicitly stated in these conditions. Nor does it include the cost of any Visas, should the destination country require them.** Total package value is not to exceed \$5,000. The Winner must decide upon a destination and a restaurant by May 1, 2018 and commence travel no later than March 1, 2019. All travel arrangements must be booked through Aleph Bet or its designated representative. Blackout dates may apply.
- The Winner must be at least 21 years of age. The Winner may be required to provide proof of age acceptable to Aleph Bet. Members of the Aleph Bet Board of Trustees are not eligible to win the raffle.
- The Winner will receive a W-2G form from Aleph Bet, and the value of the Prize will be treated as ordinary income to the winner for federal and state income tax purposes and that the Winner may be required to pre-pay a portion of the tax liability prior to receiving the Prize. If the winner is outside the U.S., the rate of tax is 30%.
- Prior to accepting the Prize, Winner may be required to provide to Aleph Bet with a W-9, a clear and readable photocopy of identification (such as a driver's license or passport), social security number, and any additionally required forms Aleph Bet may require the completed documents, withholding tax payment, and current proof of personal official identification and valid social security number before Prize is released to the Winner. The Winner represents and warrants to Aleph Bet that all information submitted with respect to receipt of the Prize is complete and accurate.
